Divine Healing

I am the Lord who heals you.
Exod. 15:26.

I will take sickness away from you.
The number of your days I will fulfill.
Exod. 23:25-26.

By God's Grace, the gift of Divine Healing is for all *Ps 105:37. Acts 10:34 "God is no respecter of persons." Psalm 107:20 "He sent His Word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions."*

John 1:1-4 "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him (even our bodies); and without him was not any thing made that was made. In Him was life; and the life was the light of men."

John 1:14 "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,...." The written word was given so that the light of that life could shine and we would know what the Living Word did for us.

Ps 119:89 "Forever, O Lord, thy word is settled (established) in heaven."

Ps 89:34 "My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips."

Heb. 6:17-19 "Wherein God, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the immutability (unchangeableness) of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath.

That by two immutable (unchangeable) things (His promise and His oath), in which it was impossible for God to lie, WE might have a strong consolation (inner strength and encouragement), who have fled (to him) for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us;"

God is not a man that He should lie..Num. 23:19.

Which HOPE we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which entereth into that (Presence) within the veil.

This hope gives us the image in our soul of God's divine will for healing in our bodies.

Faith

Rom. 1:16—Gospel is power of God to all who believe. It is the seed to be sown for the harvest desired.

Heb. 11:6 “But without faith it is impossible to please him; for he that cometh to God must believe that he is and that he is a rewarder ...”

WHAT IS FAITH?

Heb 11:1 “Faith is the substance (assurance) of things hoped for, the evidence (proof) of things not seen. (faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses).”

HOW DO WE GET FAITH?

Romans 10:17 “So then faith cometh BY HEARING (what is told) and hearing by (through) the Word of God.” God's promises are life to those who find them and health to all their flesh—*Prov. 4:22*. So then our mind must be renewed for faith to be possible.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

It is vital that you understand the principle of “calling things that are not.” We see in *Romans 4:17-22* that Abraham became fully persuaded (strong consolation) that God would do what He had promised.

Rom. 4:17 “As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were..”

Paul is referring here to Genesis chapter 17 when God changed Abram's name to Abraham which meant “father of many nations. This was the means God used to convince Abraham to call for what he did not yet have in reality. God had established it BY PROMISE, but Abram had to call it into reality by mixing faith with God's Word (promise). Every time he said “I am Abraham” he was calling things that were not yet manifest (He did not have Isaac yet). This was God's method of helping him change his image and become fully persuaded concerning the promise.

WHAT DOES THIS DO?

Paul reveals more in *I Cor 1:27-28* “But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought (nothing) things that are.”

In other words God uses spiritual forces which are not seen to nullify natural things (like sickness) that are seen. This is the Bible principle of calling things that are not as though they were.

Then in *2 Cor. 4:13* Paul says “We having the same spirit of faith according as it is written, I believed and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak”. Paul is quoting David here and then David declared in *Ps 118:17* “I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.”

So you can see when it comes to divine healing this is a vital principle and we should declare to ourselves what God's Word reveals about us, regardless of the circumstances or how we feel about it. God's word is truth.

Romans 10:6-8 says “the righteousness which is of faith says...” We are not denying that sickness exists, but we are establishing what God has said to be true concerning healing even though it is not yet a reality in our bodies. We are denying sickness the right to exist in our body.

WHAT HAS GOD SAID CONCERNING HEALING?

First, we are to “casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;”

Col. 1:14 “In whom (Christ) we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sin.”

Redeemed from what?

Gal. 3:13 “Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us; for it is written cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree;”

The curse of the law *Duet. 28:15-61* includes every sickness and every affliction written and not written in the Book of the Law as well as poverty and spiritual death.

Isa. 53:4 “Surely He bore our griefs (sicknesses) and carried our sorrows (pains); yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and WITH HIS STRIPES WE ARE HEALED.”

GOD SENT HIS WORD AND HEALED US!!

Speaking of Jesus, in *Matt. 12:15-18* “great multitudes followed him and he healed them All;. That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by *Esaias (Isaiah) the prophet* saying, behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased; I will put my spirit upon him and he shall show judgment (justice) to the nations.”

I Peter 2:24 “who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness; by whose stripes we were healed.”

Matt. 8:16-17 “when the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils; and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed ALL that were sick:”

That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by *Isaiah the prophet*, saying, Himself took our infirmities and bare our sicknesses.

Mark 15:15-18 Jesus said “He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved (healed); but he that believeth not shall be damned...they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.”
