Outreach Ministry – How to Share your faith!

Gal 3:19 points out the purpose of the law is to expose sin (expose to men their guilt because of transgressions and make them conscience of sin) AND to point man to a more excellent way to serve God through Jesus Christ.

As His indwelling Spirit leads us through the word, we learn to walk in Love, which preserves us. When we sin and God shows us His mercy, we love Him all the more.

The enemy has tricked the world to stay in bondage because of their imperfections but God has sent you, as His Ambassador, to reveal to them the Good News of their redemption.

HOW DO WE GET STARTED?

Most of us have a very real fear of approaching strangers and talking about the things of God. If and when you do, you don't want to blow it. You are concerned that it might start a lifetime feud with the neighbor, or real problems with the mother in law.

These are fears that we all have and they are very real.

However, there are certain principles that can help us bring them into perspective.

Think of **WHAT** it is you fear. Then think of the terrible fate of those who die in their sins.

Which is worse?

Remember, in evangelism, you have a similar responsibility as that of a firefighter. Think of his moral obligation as he looks at the mother screaming for help from a 6 story building on fire.

YOU also must deal with YOUR fear in light of the sinner's terrible fate.

The following 7-step summary will be used in our evangelism (outreach).

- 1. **Be** friendly. Always approach them from the natural realm.
- 2. Turn the conversation to the subject of spiritual things.
- **3. Ask**, "Would you consider yourself to be a good person?"
- 4. Ask, "Do you think you have kept the 10 commandments?" (This is where we use the 10 commandments to convict".)
- **5. Ask**, "On the Day of Judgment, if God judges you by the 10 commandments, will you be innocent or guilty?"
- **6. Ask**, "Will you go to Heaven or Hell?"
- **7. Share** the Gospel (if receptive) and pray a prayer of confession with the new convert.

SEVEN is **God's number of perfection** and if you can remember these **7 stepping stones**, you can confidently lead any

witnessing encounter – AND – you will be in control of every conversation you have regarding your faith. YOU WILL KNOW exactly where you are and exactly where the conversation is going. Now you can SAY GOODBYE TO YOUR FEAR OF EVANGELISM (outreach).

Step 1 – Be Friendly! Talk with people. Practice being friendly at the gas station, grocery store, park, etc. You will find most people respond warmly to warmth.

A simple "Hi, how are you", is not hard **OR** "nice day isn't it? My name is"

Once you see that most people are warm, it will help calm your wild fears and imaginations.

Step 2 – Turn the conversation to the subject of Spiritual things.

Now that you have some confidence in talking to people, you are ready for step two.

NEVER walk up to someone and immediately begin sharing Jesus. (I bet that's a relief).

Start in the NATURAL REALM, (so they don't think you are a religious nut) and then make the transition to the spiritual. Do it any way you want, just so it leads you directly into a conversation about God. Jesus is our example in John 4:7-26, (the woman at the well).

You may begin with football, OR the weather, OR you might simply ask if he\she knows of a good church in the area?

Another approach is using a gospel tract. Simply say, "Hi, where are you from? I'm from Springfield, etc." THEN hand him\her the gospel tract and ask, "Did you get one of these?" (Example one of the 1 million dollar bill tracts).

Then ask, "Have you a Christian background?"

It doesn't matter HOW you do it, only that you DO IT!

Remember, most people are NOT offended when the subject of God comes up, regardless of what our over ripe, fear filled imaginations tell us.

Step Three - Ask, "Would you consider yourself to be a good person?"

There's no doubt, the most difficult thing in outreach is bringing up the things of God. However, this step is not quite so hard now. It just naturally issues out of asking someone about spiritual things (from step 2).

If the response to this question is "NO", "ask them what they mean". They are probably kidding or have done something bad.

Otherwise expect "I'm a pretty good person" OR "I'm a really good person".

This reveals their proud self-righteousness.


