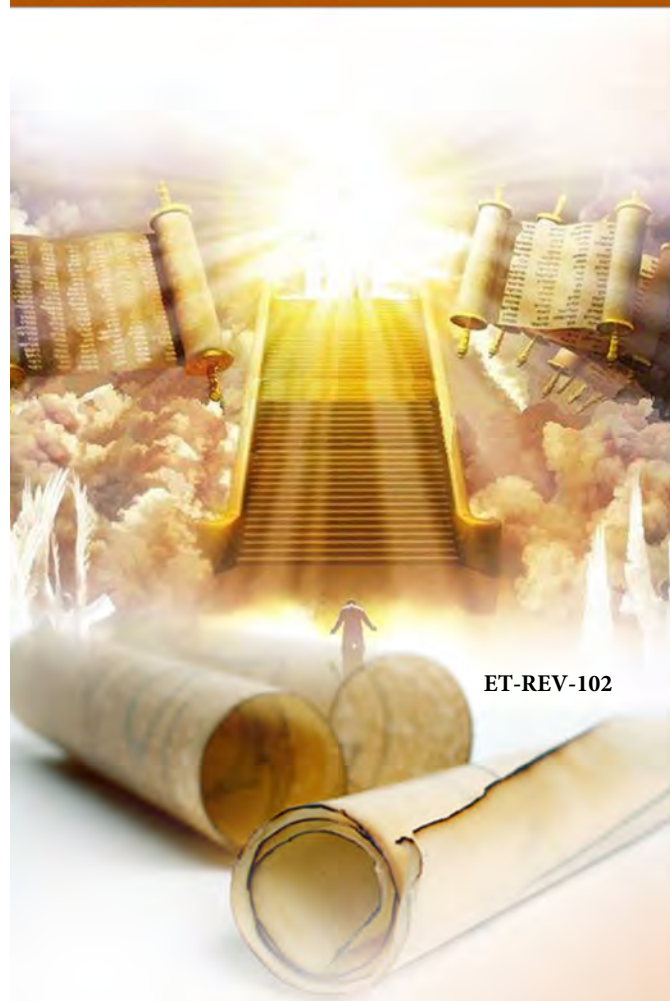

AN OVERVIEW OF REVELATION IN CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER

Rev. 1,2,3 Rev. 4,5	<p><u>Introduction and message to the seven churches.</u></p> <p>Catching up (rapture) of the Church Scene before God's Throne Identification of the 24 elders Jesus' receiving the book with 7 seals.</p>
Rev. 6	<p>Opening of the <u>first 6 SEALS.</u></p> <p>The first: White horse—Antichrist The second: Red horse—War, World War III. (Ezek. 38:11, 39) The third: Black horse—famine. The fourth: Pale horse—Death (accompanied by Hell). The fifth: Martyred Tribulation saints.</p>
Rev. 7	<p>The sixth: Tremendous Earthquake reserved until end of Tribulation.</p> <p>Two Groups revealed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The 144,000 Jewish evangelists who begin ministry early in Tribulation's first year. (vs 1-8.) (Rev.. 14:1-5; Ezek. 9:4) - The Great Multitude (mid-Tribulation saints) caught up to God's throne. (v. 9)
Rev 8,9,10	<p>Mid-Tribulation. (see table 1) →</p> <p>Seventh seal: Ushers in 7 TRUMPET judgments (Cont. from chap. 6)</p> <p>First—fourth: Plagues used intermittently throughout 3½ years. Fifth: First woe—Demon locusts, no death, five month duration. (Rev. 9) Sixth: Second woe—<u>Eastern army</u> destroyed at Armageddon. (Rev. 9) Seventh: Third woe—Reserved until end of Tribulation. (Rev. 11)</p>
Rev 11,12,13	<p>Two Witnesses: (Rev. 11)</p> <p>Israel escapes to wilderness. (Rev. 12)</p>
Rev. 14	<p>Mark of the Beast. (Rev. 13.)</p> <p>Angelic ministry. (Rev 8:13; 14:6-20)</p>
Rev. 15,16	<p>144,000 complete ministry and appear with Christ — No further reference in story.</p>
Rev. 17,18	<p><u>Last 7 Plagues, approximately 30 days</u></p> <p>Insight to Armageddon (Rev. 14:14-20; 16:16; 19:11-21; Zech. 14)</p>
Rev. 19	<p>Christ returns with His Saints. (Zech. 14:5; Rev. 17:14) Battle of Armageddon. (Rev. 19:11.21; Zech. 14) Antichrist and False Prophet cast into lake of fire. (Rev. 19:20)</p>

Rev. 20	<p><u>1,000 year reign of Jesus Christ on earth.</u> (begins last day of tribulation) Martyrs are resurrected. Saints reign as kings and priests. Satan is bound for 1,000 years. Israel is totally restored.. (Isa. 35;; Ezek. 36)</p>
Rev. 20:7-10	<p>Release of Satan (to tempt all who <u>did not receive Christ during millennium</u>)</p>
Rev. 20:11-15	<p>Final battle with Satan. Final (last) resurrection of wicked dead.</p>
Rev. 21, 22	<p>White Throne Judgment. New Jerusalem, new heaven, new earth.</p> <p>Note: <u>Jacob's trouble</u> (Jer. 30:7) refers to the last half of the 7 year Tribulation period. <u>Jacob</u> was renamed <u>Israel</u>. (Gen. 32:28).</p>

TABLE 1 Mid-Tribulation Events	

1.	Antichrist breaks agreement with Israel. (Dan. 9:24-27)
2.	Tribulation Saints (Jews & Gentiles) caught up and escape wrath of Antichrist. (Rev. 7:9-17)
3.	Major Earthquake. (Rev. 8:5)
4.	Antichrist moves against Israel; remnant of Israel hidden away. (Dan. 9; Rev. 12:13-17)
5.	Antichrist destroys the religious system (world church Harlot). (Rev. 17:16-18)
6.	Antichrist declares himself God. (2 Thess. 2:3-4)
7.	False prophet introduces mark of the Beast and attempts to control commerce. (Rev. 13:16-18)
8.	False prophet introduces idolatry—worship of the image. (Rev. 13:14,15)
9.	Two witnesses complete ministry. (Rev. 11:7)
10.	Angelic ministry begins. (Rev. 14:6-9)
11.	Plagues begin. (Rev. 8,9)
