- I. John 5:1-9
    - A. People believed a person could be healed in pool.
    - B. Verse 4 is questioned for authenticity.
      - 1. Most original manuscripts leave it out.
      - 2. Many scholars believe it was inserted by a translator.
    - C. "Wilt thou be made whole?"
      - 1. Man relates need to get into pool.
      - 2. Jesus says nothing about pool.
    - D. When man is healed no one else seems to notice.
  - II. John 5:10
    - A. Religious leaders did not notice or care that the man was healed.
    - B. Did not desire to know who healed him, only who told him to carry his bed on the Sabbath.
    - C. "Sin no more". Sickness is the result of sin in the earth.
- Verse 16—Leaders set against Him to destroy Him..

## *Madman of Gadara*

- I. Mark 5:1
  - A. Gadara was famous for the man who lived in the tombs.
  - B. Disciples knew where they were.
- II. Mark 5:2-15
  - A. Matthew 8:28-34
    1. Matthew says 2 men were in the tombs.
    2. One was more vocal and aggressive.
  - B. Ability to break chains and fetters came from demonic power within him.
  - C. Tried to argue their right to be in the man. They have no right unless men live outside of God's laws.
  - D. "Legion" - approx. 5,000—6,000 in number.
  - E. Raising hogs was in violation of Mosaic law.
  - F. Once the man was free, he desired to be clothed.
  - G. What happened to demons after hogs died?
- III. Mark 5:16-19
  - A. People were upset with Him because He hurt their business.
  - B. The Gospel came to them and they loved darkness more than light.
  - C. Delivered man instructions to tell everyone what God had done for him—opposite of earlier instructions in Galilee.

## *Woman with Issue of Blood & Jairus' Daughter*

- I. Mark 5:21-24
  - A. Came back to Capernaum.
  - B. Crowds came because they had heard of His miracles.
  - C. Jairus

1. Ruler of synagogue where demoniac had been delivered and had been in delegation for Centurion's servant.
2. Knew Jesus could heal the sick.
3. "... . Fell at His feet." Humbled himself.
4. Very powerful and influential man.
5. He dictated how Jesus would heal his daughter. Notice difference between him and Centurion.

### II. Mark 5:25-34

- A. Issue of blood made her unclean to be in public by Levitical Law. Punishable by stoning and Jairus had power to decree it to be done.
- B. "Heard of Jesus" - Romans 10:17
- C. She also dictated how she would receive.
- D. "... thy faith hath made thee whole." Jesus did not pray for her.

### III. Mark 5:35-43

- A. Imagine anxiety of Jairus.
- B. Evil report came and Jesus dismissed it by telling Jairus to keep on believing.
- C. Could hear the professional mourners at the house.
- D. Dismissed them to rid the house of the unbelieving atmosphere.
- E. Healed her exactly as Jairus dictated. He laid hands on.

## *Two Blind Men Healed*

### I. Matthew 9:27

- A. Leaves Jairus.
- B. Two blind men begin to call after Him.

### II. Matthew 9:28-31

- A. Came to His house and blind men followed Him.
- B. They overcame several obstacles to get to Him. They were determined.
- C. "Believe ye ..." Jesus wanted to know if they had faith, the key ingredient in receiving from God.

1. Shows us that our faith is important.
  2. It is not merely up to Him.
- D. Told them to keep quiet.
1. Again He did not desire to draw people to Himself by miracles.
  2. They disobeyed and what Jesus thought would happen did.

## *Commissioning of Disciples to Heal the Sick*

### I. Matthew 9:35-38

- A. Jesus loved to set people free from chains of bondage. (*Lk 4:18*)
- B. Realized He could never get to them all.

### II. Matthew 10:1-15

- A. Answered His own prayer for more laborers by commissioning disciples.
- B. Their power came from Him.
- C. Were to go only to the Jews
- D. Instructed to preach first about the kingdom of heaven.
- E. Were to heal the sick, etc.
- F. They were not to make provision for money or clothing.
  1. Jesus did not want them encumbered, on urgent mission
  2. Wanted them to learn how to depend on God.
  3. Need to accept the gifts of the people.
- G. Instructed to be gracious in the homes of the people where they stayed.
- H. If message was not received they were to move on.

### III. Matthew 10:16-20

- A. Jesus warned to be on the watch for the wickedness of men's hearts.
- B. He told them in advance that some would reject the Gospel and try to do them harm.
- C. Advised them to expect God's wisdom to flow in their lives.
