#### TRUE SEED OF ABRAHAM

Gal. 3:16 - Now to Abraham and His Seed were the promises made, He saith not unto seeds as of many; but as of one. And to thy seed which is Christ. Gal 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. Gal 3:29 - and if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abrahams seed, and heirs according to the promise.

#### FAITH FOR THE COVENANT

Gal 3:6-8 - Even as Abraham "believed" God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness; 3:7 - know ye therefore that only they which are of faith (people who live by faith), the same are the children of Abraham. 3:8 - And the scripture for seeding that God would justify (declare righteous) the heathen (gentiles) through faith, preached beforehand the **gospel** unto Abraham saying "in thee shall all nations be blessed. (gospel is the good news of a savior).

Gal. 3:22 - But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise, by faith in Jesus Christ, might be given to <u>them that believe</u>.

Gal. 3:13-14 - Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us, for it is written cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree. (and He was innocent so the curse He received is contributed to your account). that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles so that we through faith might receive the realization of the promise of the Holy Spirit. Rom. 4:13 - not through the law but the righteousness of faith.

# WHO ARE ISRAELITES? (True Seed).

Rom. 9:6-8 - For they are not all Israel (descendents of Jacob), which are of the (true) Israel.

9:7 - and they are not all the children of Abraham because they are by blood his descendents, but "in Isaac shall they seed be called."

John 1:12 - But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name.

II Cor. 4:4 - In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not...

Rom. 9:6 - they are not all Israel (Jacob) who are of Israel who are the true seed. Rom. 9:7 - nor because they are Abraham's (earthly) seed are they heirs to the promise.

Rom. 9:8 - but the children of the promise are counted as the seed.

The natural Jew believes everything revolves around circumcision. BIG MIS-TAKE!

Gal. 3 - The Jewish nation got nothing through circumcision. - It is just a sign that they had faith in God. (sign with no faith).

Gal. 3:7-8 only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. (It is by faith that it might be by grace).

We are justified by faith in the completed work of Calvary. Abraham had faith - Was He saved, yes? Born again, No! Jesus was the first born from death.

Gal. 3: 7-8 - the scripture foreseeing that God would justify the nations (all) by faith -

Jesus must be separated from God, take our sins, be cut off from the Father, die spiritually, to reverse what Adam did. Adam sinned in the garden of Eden.

Jesus came as the 2nd Adam and when through life experiencing the same thing but without sin.

Gen. 15 - Gal. 3:8-9 - God preached the gospel to Abraham - told the complete plan of His son.

So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham. (Read Gen. 12 & 13 for the blessings).

Gen. 15:6 - Abraham believed God. (they were already making sacrifices to walk be-tween.

(There was a deeper meaning here that we believe today).

God had already instituted the covenant. He was already making sacrifices to walk between.

Gen. 15:9-12 - Abraham was horrified when He saw what (his seed) the children of Israel had to go through. But I believe that part of that horror also was that he saw the son of God suffering for us; an actual member of the God Head. Abraham entered into covenant with Father God and Jesus Christ. John 8:39-42 - "Abraham is our father". John 8 43-44 - Jesus responded Your father is the devil. He was telling the children of Israel they are not of God. John 8:56 - Father Abraham rejoiced to see my day and He saw it and was glad!

Abraham believed in the gospel. John 8:51-58 Jesus said "I am I am" Gal. 3:15-16 - To Abraham and his seed ... to one, not many, who is Christ.

You must be born again. <u>We too must</u> <u>believe.</u> II Cor. 5:17 - if any man be in Christ he is a new creation. Gal 3:29 - and if you are Christ's, then you are Abrahams seed and heirs according to the promise.
